LOOKING UP ONE ASSESSMENT ON A GROUP OF STUDENTS

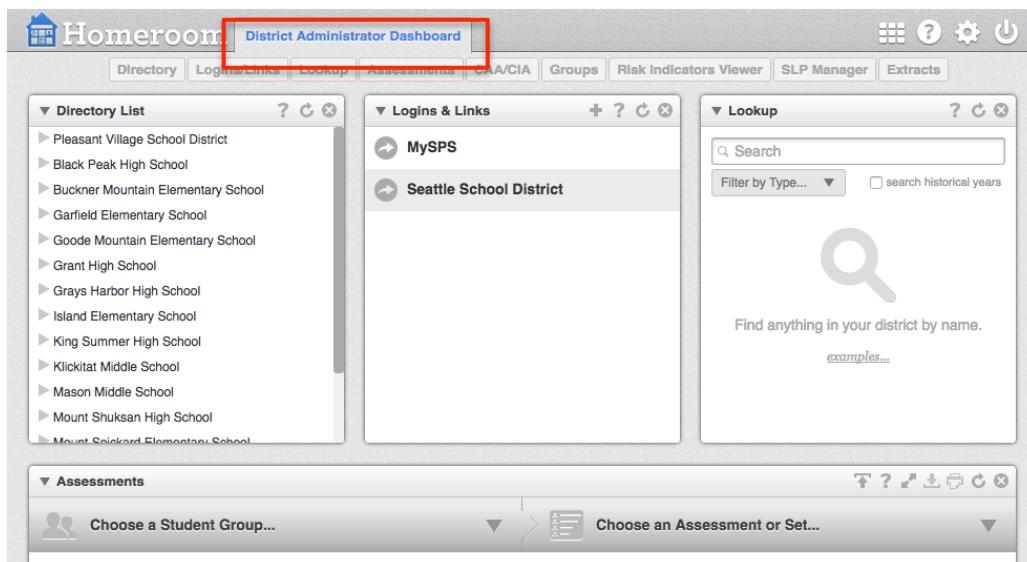


Recommended browsers: Chrome, Safari, Firefox

To log in:

1. Open a Web Browser and enter your district specific address:
 - a. [\[yourdistrictname\].schooldata.net/homeroom](#)
2. Type in your username and password, click **Sign In**.
3. If you do not remember your password, click **Reset Password**
4. If you are not activated, select **activate account**

Once signed in you will be directed to your User Dashboard

- 1) From the Dashboard, navigate to the Assessments Widget. Here you will have two choices: 1st – select your student group and 2nd– select the assessment you'd like to view:

You can select your personally created student groups, or select default groups made for you based on your permissions

An assessment with a carrot next to it means there are claims you will also be able to view

Selecting the drop down carrot will help you filter your results better!

- 2) Once you select your assessment, the widget will automatically display your student group and the scores they received on that one assessment.

3) Select the “i” to see which students specifically received that performance level score.

The display breaks the scores down by number and percentage for each performance level

4) Selecting the “+” allows you to add those students at that performance level to a group or create a new group!

1) Select the “+”
 2) Type in the name of your group and click create
 - OR -
 3) Choose a student group to add the students to and click “add to”

5) Not only can you create student groups based on the performance levels, but you can view assessments that have multiple claims at once! Select view claims for assessments that have multiple claims.
