Key Performance Indicators allow the district to create an easy-to-understand visual representation of data that represent key performance objectives to share with stakeholders. The goal is to “create conversations about the data.” These indicators can be downloaded as a pdf, or the look of the web interface can be adjusted per the user's preference.



## ACCESSING KPI

KPIs may be accessed by navigating to the **KPI App** within the **Data Extracts Bundle**, clicking **Launch App**, and then clicking **Browse KPI** from the left navigation menu.



Next, browse to find a chart of your choice and click [Browse Category](#). Finally, the district decides what to present to the users on this page.


