Preferences (Back to [Quick Links](#))


For each question, the Preferences Self-Assessment asks you to choose between two work activities. Sixty-six (66) questions must be answered before you can view your results.

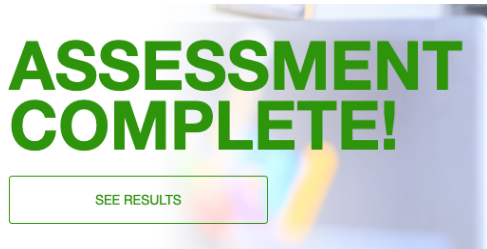

When you've answered all 66 questions and the progress bar is completely green, the "See Results" button will appear. Click on this button to see your results.




Reviewing Your Results

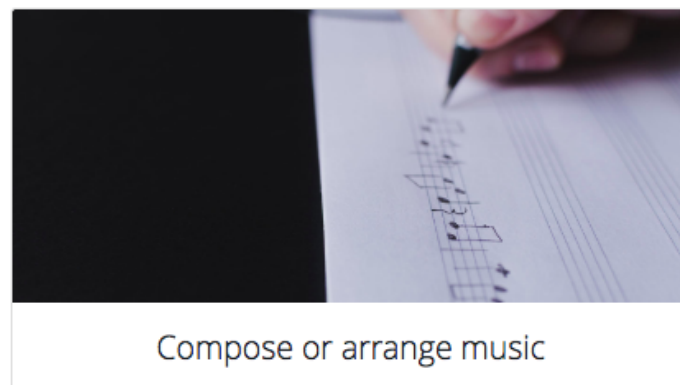
Interests (Back to [Quick Links](#))

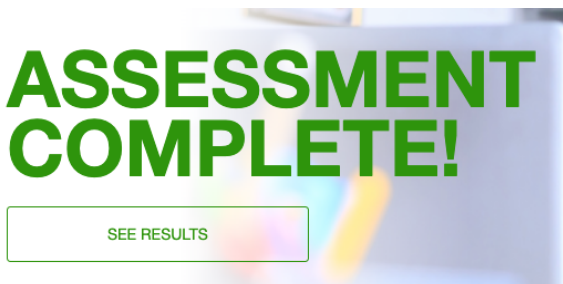


View Your Results

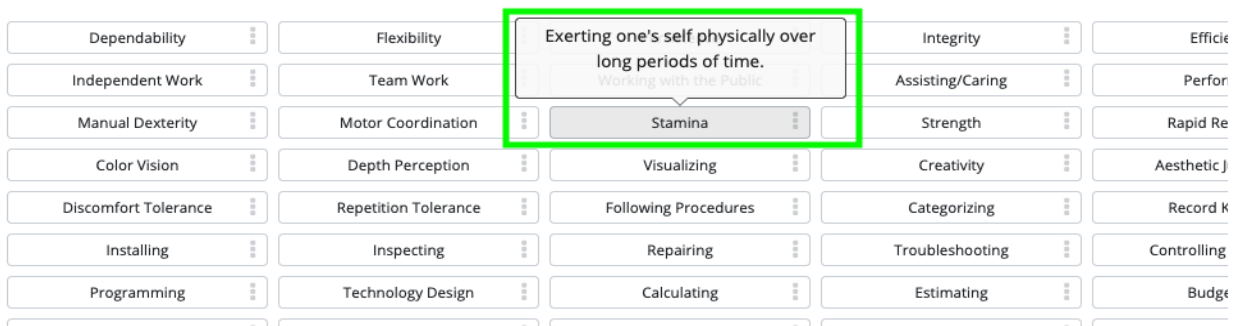
Skills [\(Back to Quick Links\)](#)

Scroll over the skill vocab words to their definition.

Drag the skills you like to use into the box that shows how much you like to use the skills.



Next, click on the vocab words and drag them to one of the three sections below.

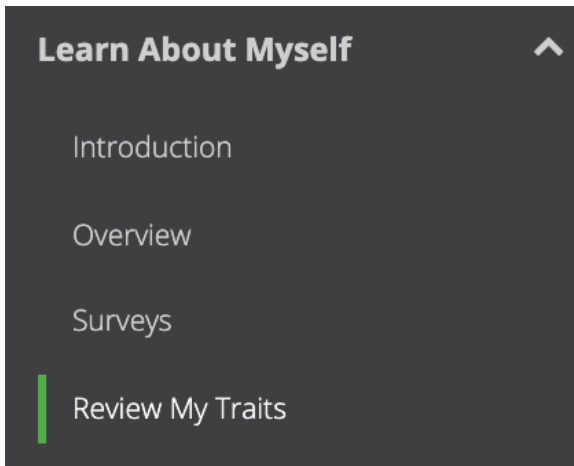

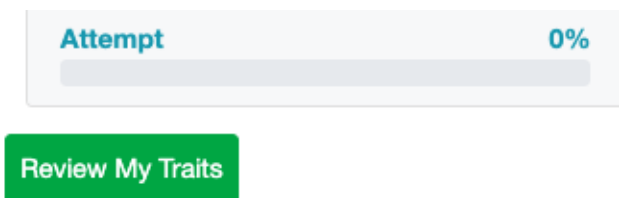
Review My Traits (Back to [Quick Links](#))

Review My Traits synthesizes your Preferences and Interests survey results to identify your strongest career matches. Because each survey measures something different, careers suggested by both are excellent places to begin your career research.

Review My Traits first shows your top three results for each survey. Next, career Areas show your results for the Preferences Self-Assessment, Personality Types show your results for the Interests Self-Assessment, and Career Clusters show your results for the Skills Self-Assessment.

 Career Cluster - Finance

In the Accounting pathway, you would record and share information about a business's finances. You would use accounting information to make decisions. Accounting includes such activities as bookkeeping and interpretation of accounts.



Employees working in the Banking Services pathway work with individuals and businesses. You would provide loans, credit, and payment services.
