



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

# Preferences (Back to Quick Links)


For each question, the Preferences Self-Assessment asks you to choose between two work activities. Sixty-six (66) questions must be answered before you can view your results.


## **Printing Your Results**


## Interests (Back to Quick Links)


# Review My Traits (Back to Quick Links)

To visit Review My Traits, click "Learn About Myself" and "Review My Traits" in the left navigation bar.




Or simply click the 'Review My Traits" button at the bottom of the surveys.
