


## ALE Application: Setting Learning Credit Enrollment Limits for Parents

A Learning Credit enrollment limit can be set and enforced upon parent enrollment for programs that weigh the classes that parents can register for. This limit can be applied across the program to all students and customized on a per-student basis on the individual Student Learning Plans.


In the **Data Admin Role**, select **Administrative Tasks** from the left navigation menu and scroll down to **Mass Apply Parent Learning Credit**.

The setting is applied to all SLPs but can be customized within individual SLPs on the Details tab in the Learning Credit Limit field.
