

ALE Applications: Configuring Reference Data Selections

These are the building blocks used to build the system's courses and student learning plans. They include the State Course Codes, Learning Activities, Objectives and Standards, etc. We typically load default data. If you want to change any available data, you can go about it in a couple of ways.

We can provide a spreadsheet with all the reference data if you want to make significant changes or load your curriculum list or standards. You can delete/add/build your lists as you desire, and then our programmers can upload them into the system once you are ready.

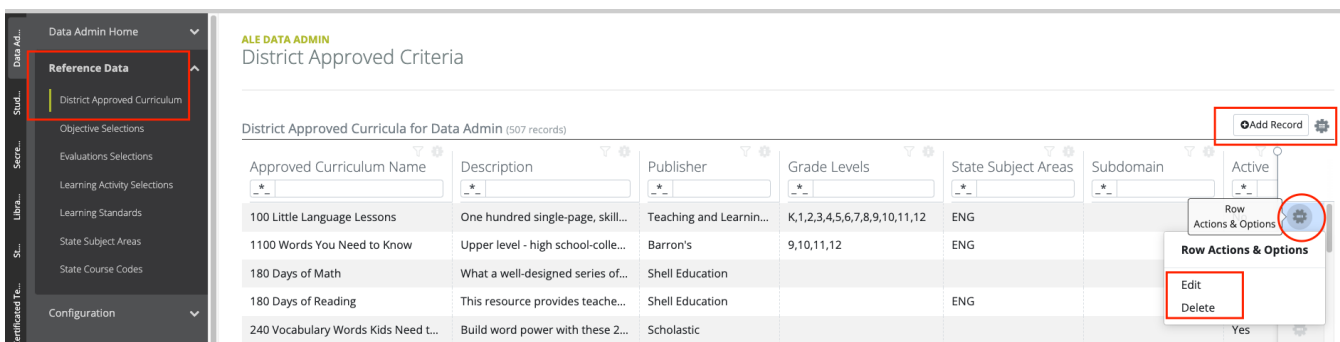
If you only want to make minor changes/updates, anyone with the **Data Admin Role** can manage the Reference Data.
