


Creating Student Groups Based on 504 Filters


In Homeroom, there is the ability to make student groups based on impairments, accommodations types, and/or accommodations. This allows users to quickly find which students they need to make accommodations for and group them easily.

Go to [yourdistrictname].schooldata.net

Select **Student Groups** on the left navigation pane, then **Create v1 Student Group.** Select the **Filter & Create** tab.




Next, select Add Filter Group.




The first **Add Filter Group** will be **Enrollments**: what population of students should we be targeting? Most likely the entire district, grade, or school. The number of students in the group is displayed on the right side in the number. Click on the number to see who the students are.


Creating Student Groups With The 504 Flag As Active In The Student Information System


Select **Student Groups** on the left navigation pane, then **Create v1 Student Group.** Select the **Filter & Create** tab.






Next, select Add Filter Group.
