

## January 9th, 2020 LUNCH AND LEARN

### Q & A

Questions and answers from the January 9th Homeroom Dashboard Lunch and Learn are listed below. Please contact [support@schooldata.net](mailto:support@schooldata.net) if you need further clarification.

**1. I ran the district attendance overall, over 3 years: 17/18, 18/19, 19/20. Each year has 2 bars, both of which say “All students in [district] School District” (one specifies 19/20), and the percentages in the two previous years are different for both. Why is that?**

- For the 17/18 school year:
  - The blue bar would correspond to the counts for all students enrolled in the district for the 17/18 school year.
  - The yellow bar would be the counts for students in the “All Students at [district] School District (19/20)” student group, who also happened to be at the school district in the 17/18 school year.
  - Some students in the district in the 17/18 school year would not be in the 19/20 student group. An obvious example would be students who graduated at the end of the 17/18 school year.
- For the 18/19 school year:
  - The blue bar would correspond to the counts for all students enrolled in the district for the 18/19 school year.
  - The yellow bar would be the counts for students in the All Students at Richland School District (19/20) student group who also happened to be at the school district in the 18/19 school year.
  - Like the 17/18 school year, some students in the district in the 18/19 school year would not be in the 19/20 student group. An obvious example would be students who graduated at the end of the 18/19 school year.

**2. Do the default groups only include current students?**

- "Currently Enrolled Students" vs. "Current Year Students" - default groups used on the dashboards are "Current Year Students" and many of the resulting screenviews will likely include were enrolled, now withdrawn students. But, several of the screenviews also have options for omitting those students.
- Remember that you can create a currently enrolled student group by creating a Student Group for a building that doesn't include withdrawn students.
