We are working with our programmers on an upcoming release soon, possibly the end of September or early October. Here is a list of highlights of those updates proposed for that release.

- Provide an option for Resume templates to be downloaded as Word Documents (<u>CP-291</u>)
- Display Failed and/or Incomplete Courses in Graduation Monitor (GM-32)
- Selecting an individual student from Student Completion:
  - allow the Educator to pick a student group to search from (HSB-129)
  - when a student is picked, open a new tab so an educator can pick from list again (HSB-128)
- Alert Student & Educator when a HSB Task needs review (HSB-81)
- When creating an Intervention Plan, allow selection of Intervention/Support at the same time of plan creation. (<u>HSB-116</u>)

Students investigate classes and assemble a four year plan to fulfill graduation requirements.







To avoid premature checking of the box, a confirmation notification is provided.





Changes can be made on an individual course basis, if only have a handful of items need to be changed.








#### **Individual Course updates**






#### **Mass Course updates**


Often it is best when first connecting with a district and reviewing the courses that School Data Solutions pulls a list and provides to the district for a mass review of their SIS (Student Information System) courses.

When the district has made all necessary changes, they can send the file back to SDS to upload with changes.



**State Course Codes (SCC)** is one of the most important pieces of Four Year Plan courses. It's crucial that we confirm the correct SCC is assigned as the SCC dictates the **Graduation Requirement Credit**.







#### **Template Updates/Additions**

Every district is given Default Templates upon set up. These are just fine for Districts to use. However, the benefit of building your own templates is that it gives you the ability to customize them specifically to your school and students.




## **Four Year Plan Customization**

Districts can pair courses together, so when students pick the course in Four Year Plans it will offer to add the paired course(s) for them.






Every student, and now Educators, sees the "Important Information" page. Overall text can be updated, and now individual Content blocks as well if different schools need to relay/maintain separate information.






#### **State Course Codes**

Each row is a **State Course Code**, by default only those that are used on a course are displayed. Each column to the right represents a **Graduation Requirement**.



If there is a **green check** in it, then that State Course Code is tied to that subject or sub-type.

In the example, in **Four Year Plans** on courses with the State Course Code **01001**, it will display an **E** noting it is tied to **English**.





### **Graduation Monitor Customization**




#### **Graduation Credit Counts**

Each row is a **Graduation Base year**; each column to the right represents a **Graduation Requirement Credit Count**.



The number in the count is what used to calculate On Track, At Risk, or Requirement Met status for each Graduation Requirement.

Viewing a student's Graduation Monitor status, it will show credit tally if a student is **On Track**, **At Risk** or **Requirement Met** in the necessary categories.




