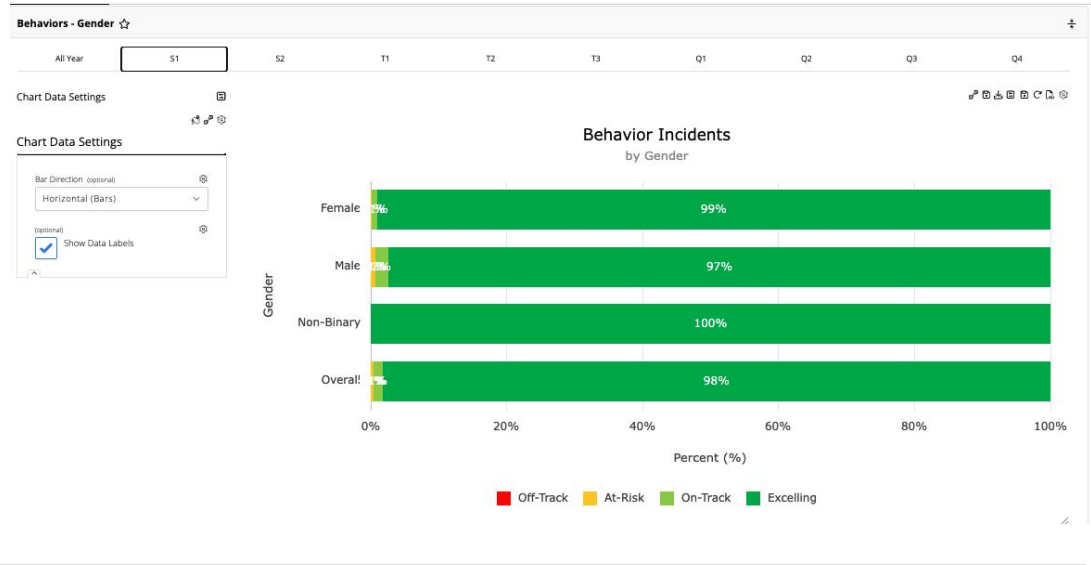

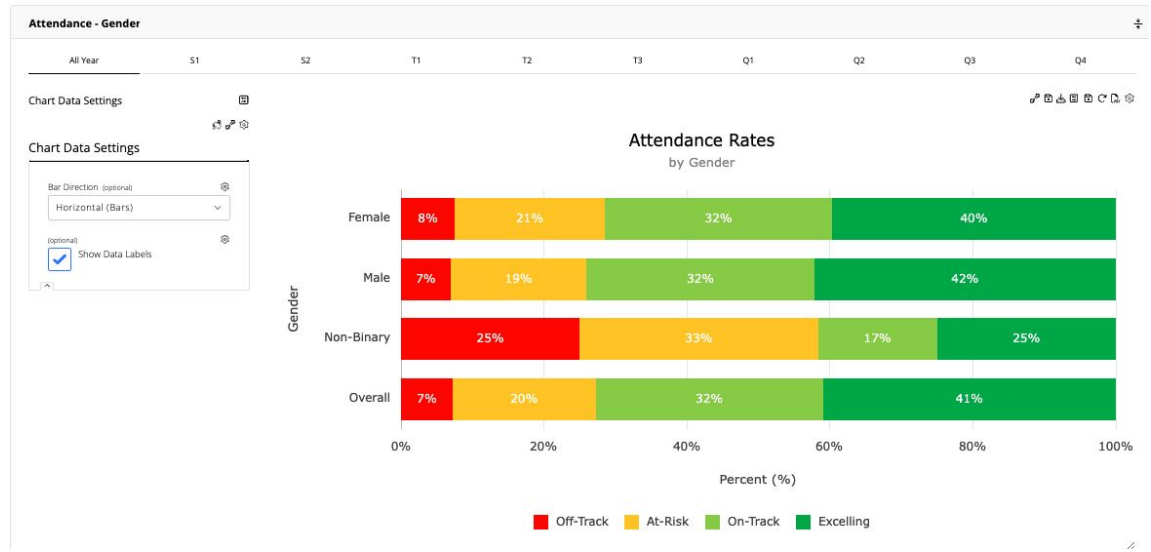


Attendance Charts

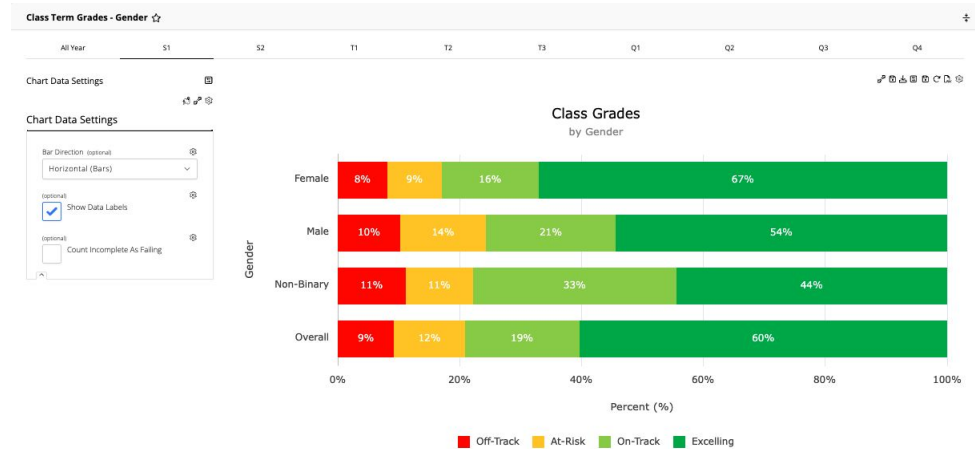


Class Grades

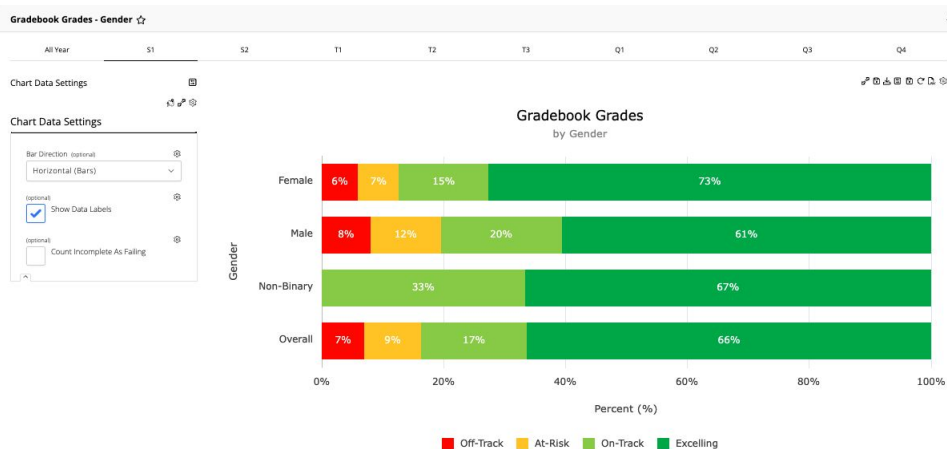
