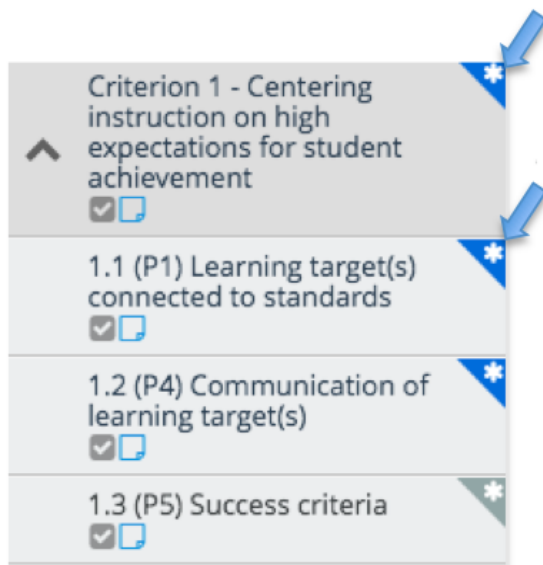

Marking Focus Criterion

Any criteria can be marked as focused by either the Evaluator or Evaluatee by clicking the corner triangle checkmark, which turns it from grey to blue. Once a criterion has been marked as focused, each instance of the criteria will display the focus label for the entire evaluation year.

NOTE: If the task has already been marked as complete, this cannot be done on the task as it is 'read only'. The user must click on the Summary.



If the Evaluatee is on Focus for one year, either the Evaluator or Evaluatee will need to mark all criteria, including the Student Growth criterion, as the focus to ensure the Final Evaluation is handled correctly.

Displaying only the Focus Criterion

From an Observation/Evaluation task (Observation/Evaluation):

Click on the **Configuring Gear icon** in the right corner of your screen. Check the **Show Only Focused/Required Criteria** view option. This will eliminate the display of criteria that are not marked as 'Required' or 'Focus'. This will persist throughout the whole application.


