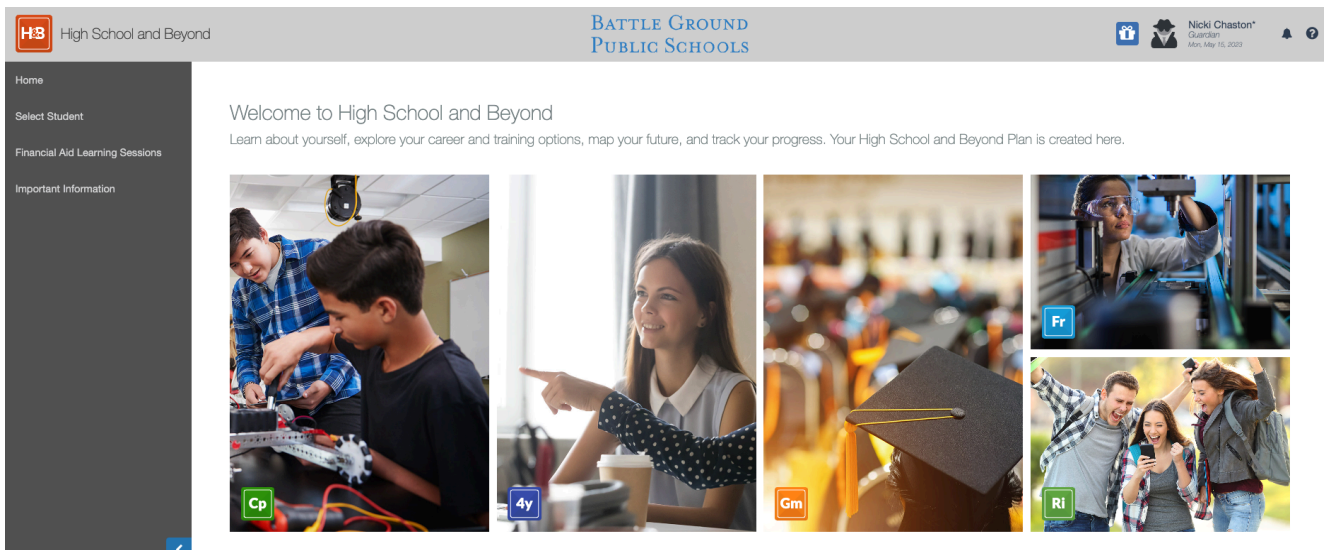


Guardian Access to High School and Beyond Guide V2

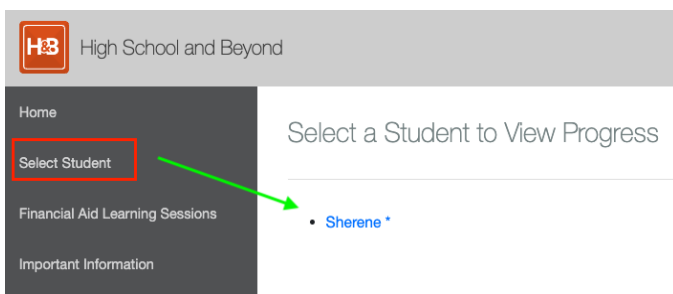

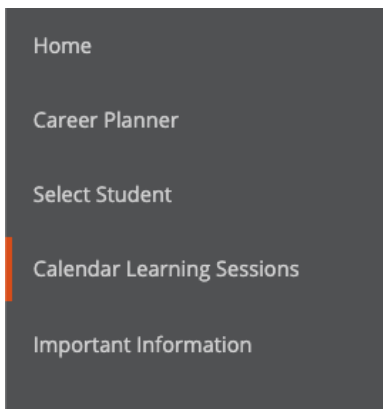
