The Early Warning Module integrates various student data points (grades, assessments, behavior, and attendance) into a single platform.

Key Features:

- Clickable Charts
- Sortable and Filterable Tables
- Individual Risk Profiles that offer a comprehensive view of a student's demographic and historical data.

Navigate the Early Warning Module

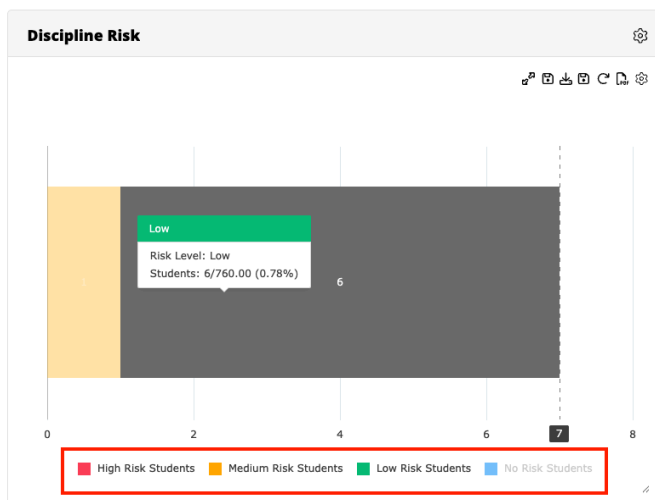
1. The header at the top left of the dashboard indicates your role. This determines the areas of information the user can access.
2. You can filter the view via the **Edit Page Data Settings** to the right of the page title.



3. Below the header is a list of containers. **Containers** hold screen views of various types of data, the most common of which are graphs, charts, and data tables.
4. Below a chart, click the **risk level ledger item** to hide the bar or column from the chart. Click again to return it.


Note: No Risk Students may be turned off by default. Click in the legend to turn on if desired.

5. **Hover** over any portion of a graph to see additional information about that graph section.



6. Click on any **colored graph region** to see the data that makes up that portion.

- a. Click the **eye icon** to view the student dashboard for more detailed information.
- b. Click the **View EWM Profile icon** for the Early Warning Module Student Profile.
- c. **Filter** columns by using the keyword search or filter icon at the top of the columns.
- d. To create a **student group**, select one or more students by checking the checkbox next to each, or select all by checking the checkbox in the top-left corner.
 - i. Click the **Selected Gear** in the top left of the data table and choose **Add Students to Student Group**.
 - ii. Select the **radio button** to **Create New Group** or **Add to Existing Group**.
 1. Fill in the student group name or select an existing group by clicking the Student Group field and clicking the checkmark to the left.
 - iii. Click **Save**.
 - iv. Navigate to **Student Groups** in the left navigation to manage the student group selections.

8. Download a chart image by clicking the download icon in the top right corner.



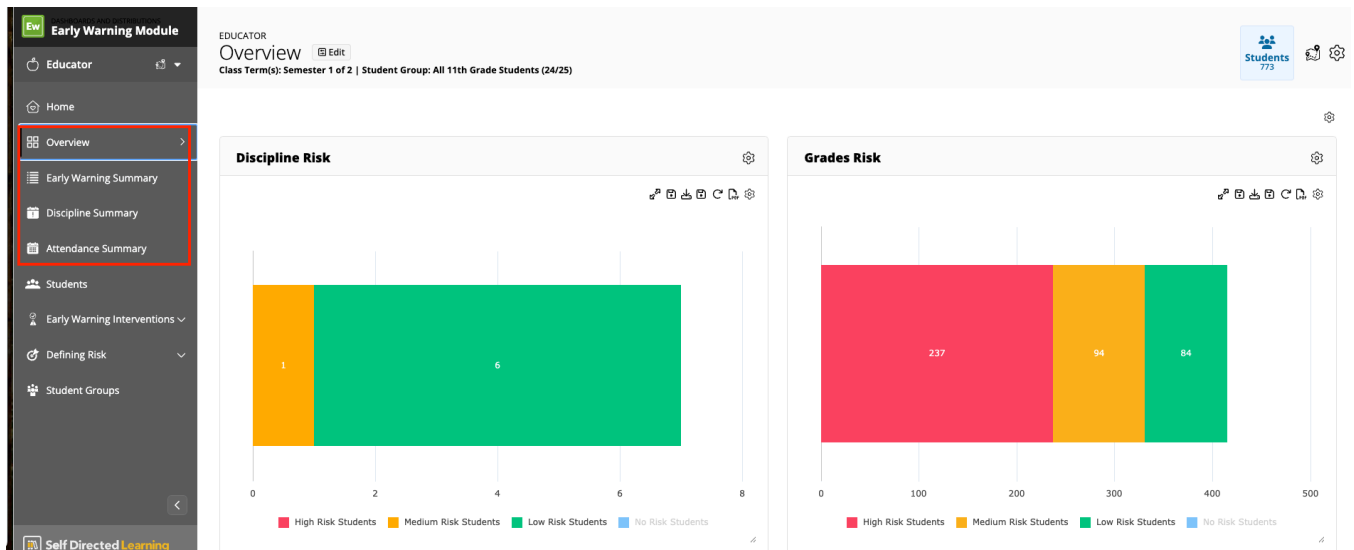

View Early Warning Module Summaries

The Early Warning Summary dashboard displays the distribution of students at low, medium, and high risk for a building or class,s depending on the user's role.

1. Start under the left navigation:
 - **Overview:** This section provides an overall summary of the discipline, grades, and attendance risk charts, as well as a monthly summary of discipline and attendance.
 - **Early Warning Summary:** Here, you will see the Discipline, Grades, and Attendance Risk Summaries, as well as Discipline, Excused, Unexcused, and Grade Risk Comparison charts between buildings.
 - **Discipline Summary:** This section displays the total number of monthly discipline incidents. Location, behavior, birth sex, and race, or by reporter charts, may further break this down. In addition, you may view Incidents reported by day, week, month, grade level, and school.
 - **Attendance Summary:** This section displays the total number of monthly attendance events. Gender, race, grade level, day, and day of the week may further break this down.





Start under **Defining Risk** in the left navigation menu and choose one of the following:

- **Grades Risk**
- **Discipline Risk**
- **Attendance Risk**

Academic insights

Declining or improving grades are often a clear indication of a student's need. Educators can review a history of the student's grades for the year, organized by grading period.

With assessment data integrated into Early Warning as well, educators get a complete picture of each student's academic standing.

The Early Warning Module also allows time-based comparisons with other factors such as attendance and discipline; if a student's risk intensifies across multiple factors at the same time, there may be a more pervasive issue to be addressed.
