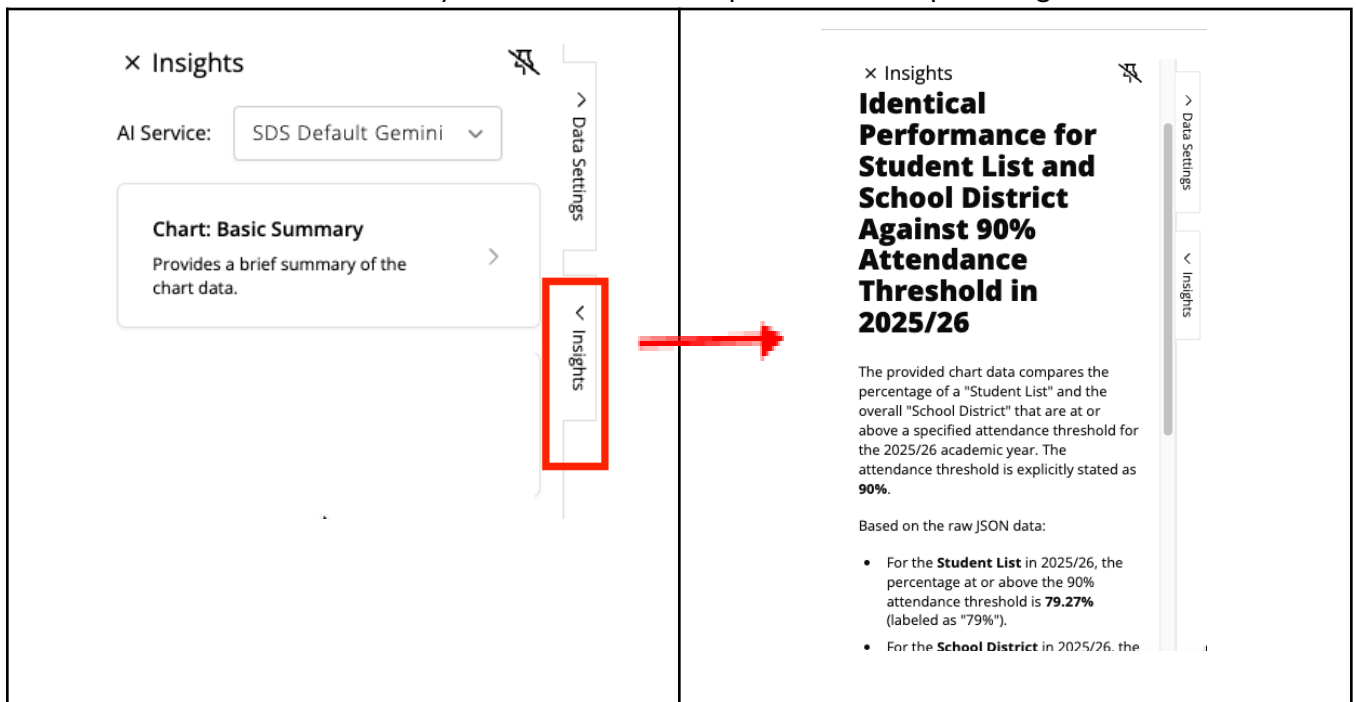



Additionally, the Evaluations application includes an "Enhance/Polish" tool in the Observation notepad, allowing evaluators to refine their notes.
