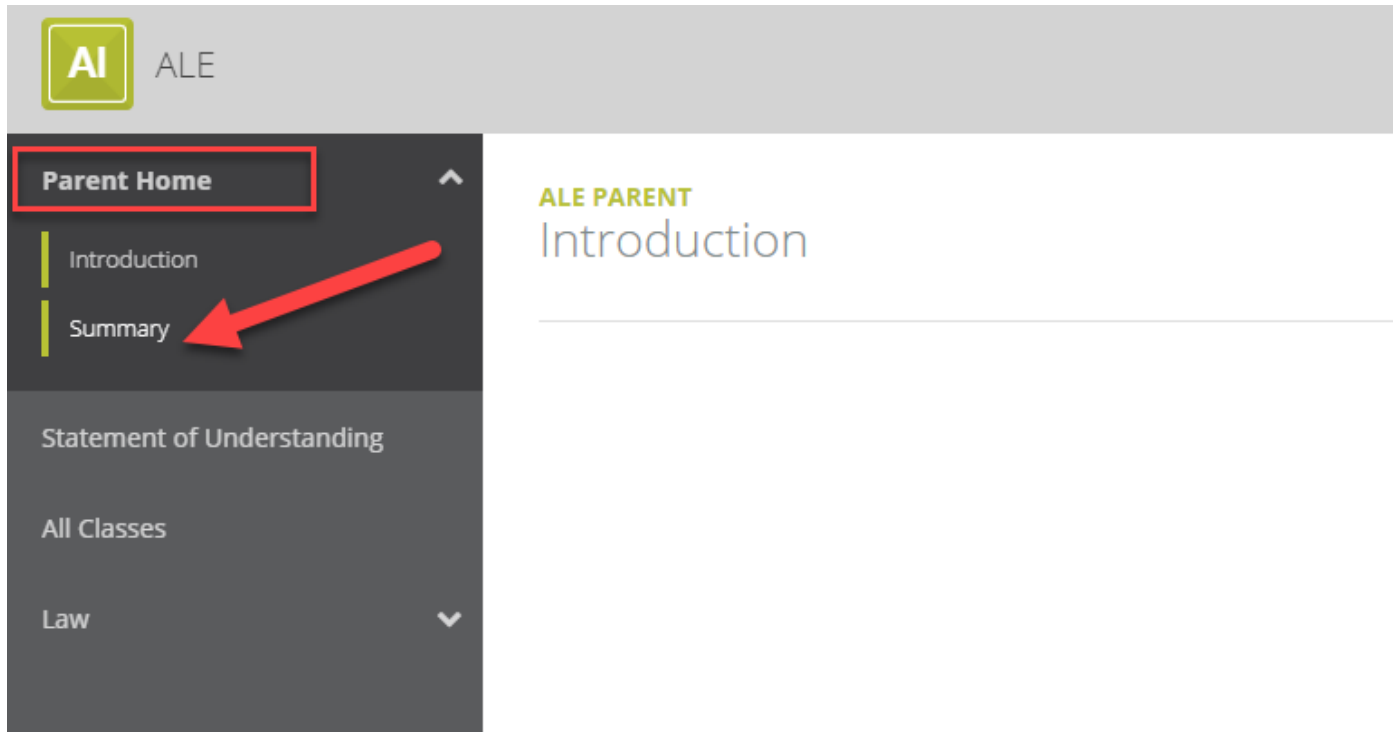
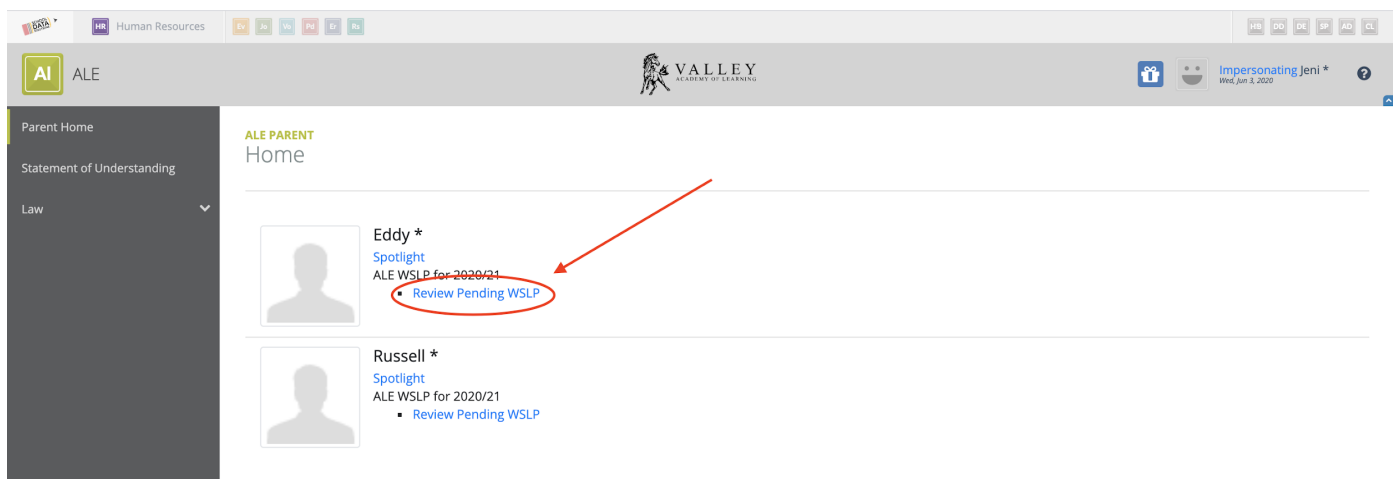


## ALE Application for Parents: Viewing the Student Learning Plan

Once you have logged in, by default you will land on the Parent Home page. Using the dropdown arrow in the left navigation menu, expand the arrow next to “Parent Home” and click on “Summary.”



You will be able to see your child’s Student Learning Plan by clicking “Review Pending WSLP” of “View WSLP” for the school year you’d like to view.



You will then be viewing the “Details” tab where you can see basic information about the plan.

You can view all of your child’s Student Learning Plan courses by navigating to the “Subjects/Courses” tab and choosing “SLP Courses:”
